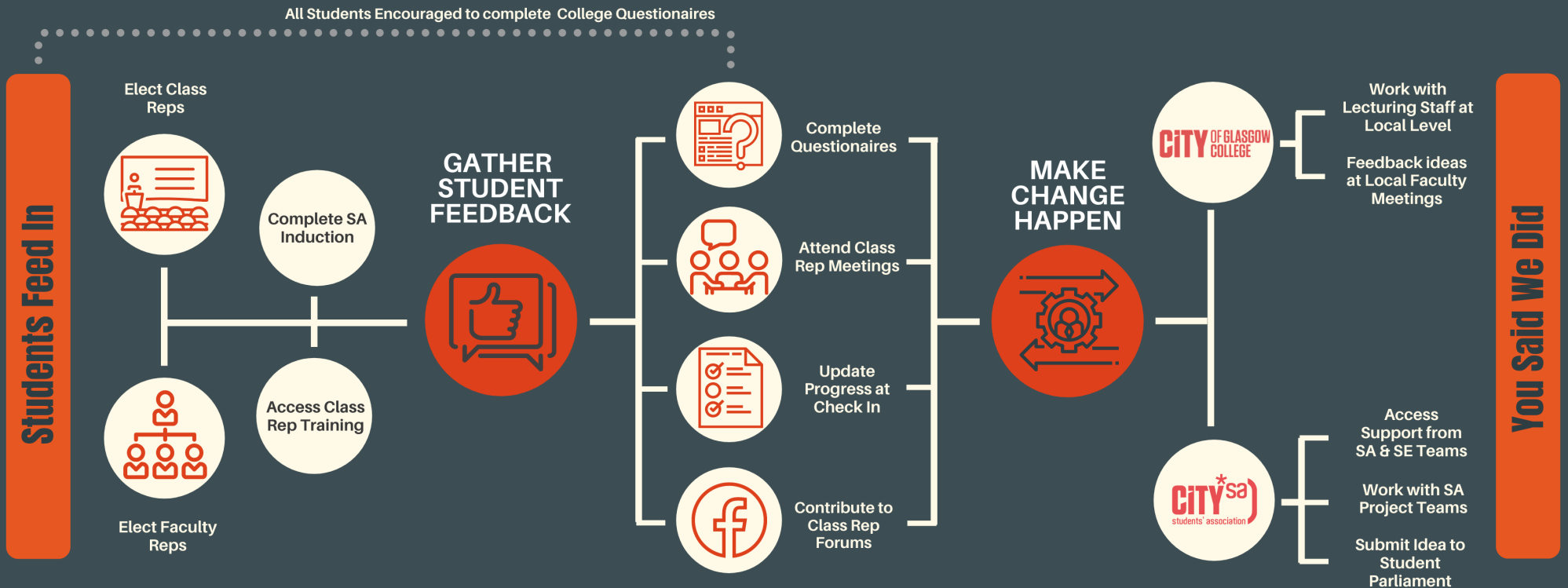
What is expected of Class Reps?
